About us: Granby Community Mental Health Group - Mary Seacole House is a registered charity and company limited by guarantee. The overall aim of the organisation is to provide services to local people who are experiencing mental illness. We have been supporting local communities since 1991. Our mission is to support and empower positive health and wellbeing, improve lives throughout our diverse communities within a safe, caring and positive environment, and give service users fair access to high standard practical and emotional support.

What is a trustee: Trustees are the individuals who take decisions at the governing body of the charity and are legally responsible for a charity.

What kind of person we are looking for: We are looking for someone who understands and is committed to our values (adopting a holistic approach, empathy, equality and integrity). We would like candidates who have skills and or qualifications relating to, delivering mental health advocacy, digital, monitoring and evaluation, finance, project management, working in the social care sector, working with BME communities. We want to increase the diversity of our board and encourage those from Black, Asian or Minority Ethnic (BAME) backgrounds to apply. Board members are unpaid and need to be able to dedicate an average of approx. 1-1.5 hours per month. Meetings take place the second Thursday of each month at 5.00pm (Presently through ZOOM). Although on occasion this may change. Emergency meetings and sub-group meetings may need to take place, but this is not on a regular basis. Away days and development days take place approx. twice per year.
